If your sponsor has had their license revoked, help is available in your local region to help you find new employment in the care sector. Email commissioning.swadass@swcouncils.gov.uk for help. Also see our Finding Health & Social Care Work Factsheet

This support can include:

- advice and guidance - help with understanding your visa status and employment rights
- employment support - support in finding a new employer who can sponsor your visa
- help with accessing financial support if you are struggling due to job loss or unpaid wages
- mental health and wellbeing support such as buddying schemes and help to access counselling.
